A PROCLAMATION

POISON PREVENTION WEEK

WHEREAS: The American Association of Poison Control Centers (AAPCC) reports that

over 2.5 million people are unintentionally poisoned in the United States

annually; and

WHEREAS: In 2019, the Georgia Poison Center assisted with over 84,000 poisoning related

calls. Over 42 percent of these calls involved children under the age of five; and

WHEREAS: Poisoning is still the leading cause of injury-related death in the United States,

especially in young children; and

WHEREAS: It is imperative for all citizens to be conscious of the dangers of poisonous

pesticides, household cleaning products, cosmetics, medications, foreign bodies,

and insect and animal bites; and

WHEREAS: Poison centers provide many services, including information and telephone

emergency services, that citizens should be aware of; and

WHEREAS: To reduce poisoning incidents in Georgia, everyone is encouraged to learn more

about the resources offered by poison centers and learn the emergency hotline

number 1-800-222-1222, which is available 24/7; now

THEREFORE: I, BRIAN P. KEMP, Governor of the State of Georgia, do hereby proclaim

March 15-21, 2020 POISON PREVENTION WEEK in Georgia.
