EXECUTIVE ORDER

BY THE GOVERNOR:

- WHEREAS:** The State of Georgia holds title to, and the Georgia Bureau of Investigation (hereinafter the "GBI") is the custodian of, approximately 5.25 acres of real Property known as the former Northwest Regional Crime Lab in Chattooga County, Georgia, (hereinafter the "Premises"), as more fully described in the survey attached hereto as Exhibit "A" and incorporated herein by reference; and
- WHEREAS:** The Premises were transferred from the Department of Corrections to the GBI by Executive order on June 29, 1990, for construction of the Northwest Regional Crime Lab, which was completed in September, 1997; and
- WHEREAS:** The GBI discontinued use of the Premises on March 31, 2010; and
- WHEREAS:** By resolution dated November 14, 2013, the Board of Public Safety resolved that the property was surplus to the needs of GBI and requested that custody of the Premises be transferred to the Department of Corrections; and
- WHEREAS:** By resolution dated November 7, 2013, the Georgia Board of Corrections requested that custody of the Premises be transferred from GBI to the Department of Corrections for use as a support building for Hays State Prison.

NOW, THEREFORE, PURSUANT TO THE AUTHORITY VESTED IN ME AS GOVERNOR OF THE STATE OF GEORGIA, IT IS HEREBY


