EXECUTIVE ORDER

BY THE GOVERNOR:

FLAGS ON STATE BUILDINGS AND GROUNDS ORDERED LOWERED TO HALF-STAFF

WHEREAS: Today, the University of Georgia Community, the families and friends affected and the citizens of Georgia mourn the loss of students who lost their lives and one who is seriously injured following a tragic automobile accident; and

WHEREAS: Ms. Kayla Leigh Canedo from Alpharetta, Ms. Brittany Katherine Feldman from Alpharetta, Ms. Christina Devon Semeria from Milton, and Ms. Halle Grace Scott from Dunwoody, will all be remembered for their commitment to serving others; and

WHEREAS: One additional student, Ms. Agnes Kim from Snellville, was seriously injured and is currently being treated for her injuries; and

WHEREAS: The people of Georgia share the grief of the families and friends of those who were injured or killed, and we pray for their comfort and healing in the days to come.

NOW, THEREFORE, IN HONOR AND AS A MARK OF RESPECT FOR THOSE AFFECTED BY THIS TRAGEDY, PURSUANT TO THE AUTHORITY VESTED IN ME AS GOVERNOR OF THE STATE OF GEORGIA, IT IS HEREBY

ORDERED: That the flag of the United States and flag of the Great State of Georgia be flown at half-staff on all State buildings and grounds on Friday, April 29, 2016, until sunset.
