## EXECUTIVE ORDER

---

BY THE GOVERNOR:

**WHEREAS:** In the early morning hours of Wednesday, June 1, 2016, as he was working as a Lyft driver, Mr. Shahriar Zolfaghari, 36, was found in his car unresponsive after having received two gunshot wounds to the torso; and

**WHEREAS:** The Atlanta Police Department has been unable to generate any solid information leading to the identification or apprehension of a suspect or suspects; and

**WHEREAS:** Section 45-12-35 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated provides that the Governor of the State of Georgia is authorized, in his discretion, to offer and cause to be paid a reward for information leading to the arrest and conviction of any person or persons who have committed a felony in the State of Georgia.

**NOW, THEREFORE, PURSUANT TO THE AUTHORITY VESTED IN ME AS GOVERNOR OF THE STATE OF GEORGIA, IT IS HEREBY**

**ORDERED:** That a reward in the amount of \$5,000.00 is hereby offered for information leading to the identification, apprehension and conviction of the individual(s) responsible for the death of Shahriar Zolfaghari.
