EXECUTIVE ORDER

BY THE GOVERNOR:

WHEREAS: The General Assembly passed House Bill 142 during the 2013 Legislative Session, which restored rulemaking authority to the Georgia Government Transparency and Campaign Finance Commission; and

WHEREAS: The Georgia Government Transparency and Campaign Finance Commission has formally requested moving its administrative attachment from the Office of the Secretary of State to the State Accounting Office, a request to which all parties formally agree.

NOW, THEREFORE, BY VIRTUE OF THE POWER VESTED IN ME AS GOVERNOR OF THE STATE OF GEORGIA, IT IS HEREBY

ORDERED: As of July 1, 2013, the Georgia Government Transparency and Campaign Finance Commission shall be assigned, for administrative purposes only, to the State Accounting Office.
