## EXECUTIVE ORDER

---

BY THE GOVERNOR:

**WHEREAS:** There currently exists a dispute over the location of a boundary between Macon County and Taylor County; and

**WHEREAS:** Pursuant to O.C.G.A. § 36-3-20, et. seq., the Clerk of Superior Court of Macon County has requested the appointment of an independent surveyor to clearly define a portion of the boundary between said counties; and

**WHEREAS:** The Secretary of State will negotiate with the appointed surveyor a rate for services to be rendered by the surveyor. The cost of services rendered by the surveyor will be split between Macon County and Taylor County.

**NOW, THEREFORE, PURSUANT TO THE AUTHORITY VESTED IN ME AS GOVERNOR OF THE STATE OF GEORGIA, IT IS HEREBY**

**ORDERED:** That Mr. Steve Coleman with Steve Coleman & Associates, Inc. Land Surveyors be appointed as the surveyor to define the boundary line between Macon County and Taylor County.
