EXECUTIVE ORDER

BY THE GOVERNOR:

WHEREAS: The Governor, on the recommendation of the Adjutant General, shall appoint an officer of the organized militia who shall be the State Judge Advocate (O.C.G.A. § 38-2-326(a)); and

WHEREAS: The officer so appointed as State Judge Advocate shall be a member of the bar of the Supreme Court of this state and shall have been admitted to the bar of this state for a period of not less than five years (O.C.G.A. § 38-2-326(a)); and

WHEREAS: The Adjutant General, The Honorable Jim Butterworth, has recommended the appointment of Lieutenant Colonel Bobby Lee Christine of Columbia County, Georgia – a member of the organized militia and member of the bar of the Supreme Court of this state and admitted to the bar of this state continuously and in good standing since 1995 – as State Judge Advocate.

NOW, THEREFORE, PURSUANT TO THE AUTHORITY VESTED IN ME AS GOVERNOR OF THE STATE OF GEORGIA, IT IS HEREBY

ORDERED: That Lieutenant Colonel Bobby Lee Christine of Columbia County, Georgia, is hereby appointed State Judge Advocate (O.C.G.A. § 38-2-326(a)) and any executive orders to the contrary are hereby revoked.
