

House Bill 1029 (AS PASSED HOUSE AND SENATE)

A BILL TO BE ENTITLED
AN ACT

1 To abolish the office of elected county surveyor of Whitfield County; to provide for the
2 appointment of a county surveyor by the governing authority of the county; to provide that
3 the person currently serving as elected county surveyor shall serve the remainder of his or
4 her term; to provide for related matters; to provide an effective date; to repeal conflicting
5 laws; and for other purposes.

6 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

7 **SECTION 1.**

8 Pursuant to the authority granted by Code Section 36-7-2.1 of the Official Code of Georgia
9 Annotated, the office of elected county surveyor of Whitfield County is abolished. The
10 governing authority of Whitfield County shall appoint a qualified person to hold the office
11 of county surveyor for a term of one year from the date of appointment. Successors shall
12 also be appointed for terms of one year. Any person appointed county surveyor shall possess
13 the qualifications specified by paragraph (1) of subsection (b) of Code Section 36-7-2 of the
14 Official Code of Georgia Annotated. The person serving as elected county surveyor of
15 Whitfield County on January 1, 2016, shall continue to serve as such until the expiration of
16 the current term to which such person was elected.

17 **SECTION 2.**

18 This Act shall become law upon its approval by the Governor or upon its becoming law
19 without such approval.

20 **SECTION 3.**

21 All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are repealed.
