

House Bill 1060 (AS PASSED HOUSE AND SENATE)

A BILL TO BE ENTITLED
AN ACT

1 To provide for the administration of the budget of the clerk of the Superior Court of Fulton
2 County; to provide that the clerk of the Superior Court of Fulton County shall have oversight
3 of the budget; to provide that the clerk, with the approval of the chief judge, shall be
4 authorized to make changes to line item appropriations; to provide that any unexpended
5 funds at the end of the fiscal year shall lapse to the general fund of Fulton County; to provide
6 an effective date; to repeal conflicting laws; and for other purposes.

7 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

8 **SECTION 1.**

9 The clerk of the Superior Court of Fulton County shall have oversight of the budget of the
10 clerk's office. After county funds have been appropriated for the operation of the clerk's
11 office, the clerk, with the approval of the chief judge of the Superior Court of Fulton County,
12 shall have the authority to make changes to line item appropriations.

13 **SECTION 2.**

14 The Fulton County Finance Department shall make all payroll adjustments related to
15 appointment, transfer, termination, or other personnel action requiring payroll adjustment
16 upon written notification by the clerk.

17 **SECTION 3.**

18 Any unexpended county appropriated funds remaining with the office of the clerk at the end
19 of a fiscal year shall lapse to the general fund of Fulton County.

20 **SECTION 4.**

21 This Act shall become effective upon its approval by the Governor or upon its becoming law
22 without such approval.

SECTION 5.

24 All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are repealed.
