## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT

- 1 To provide for the administration of the budget of the Fulton County Juvenile Court; to
- 2 provide that the chief administrative officer shall have oversight of the budget; to provide
- 3 that the chief administrative officer, with the approval of the chief judge, shall be authorized
- 4 to make changes to line item appropriations; to provide that any unexpended funds at the end
- 5 of the fiscal year shall lapse to the general fund of Fulton County; to provide an effective
- 6 date; to repeal conflicting laws; and for other purposes.

## 7 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

8 SECTION 1.

- 9 The chief administrative officer of the Fulton County Juvenile Court shall have oversight of
- 10 the court's budget. After county funds have been appropriated for the operation of the court,
- 11 the chief administrative officer, with the approval of the chief judge of the juvenile court,
- shall have the authority to make changes to line item appropriations.
- SECTION 2.
- 14 The Fulton County Finance Department shall make all payroll adjustments related to
- 15 appointment, transfer, termination, or other personnel action requiring payroll adjustment
- 16 upon written notification by the chief administrative officer.
- SECTION 3.
- 18 Any unexpended county appropriated funds remaining with the court at the end of a fiscal
- 19 year shall lapse to the general fund of Fulton County.
- SECTION 4.
- 21 This Act shall become effective upon its approval by the Governor or upon its becoming law
- 22 without such approval.
