

House Bill 1061 (AS PASSED HOUSE AND SENATE)

A BILL TO BE ENTITLED
AN ACT

1 To provide for the administration of the budget of the Fulton County Juvenile Court; to
2 provide that the chief administrative officer shall have oversight of the budget; to provide
3 that the chief administrative officer, with the approval of the chief judge, shall be authorized
4 to make changes to line item appropriations; to provide that any unexpended funds at the end
5 of the fiscal year shall lapse to the general fund of Fulton County; to provide an effective
6 date; to repeal conflicting laws; and for other purposes.

7 **BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:**

8 **SECTION 1.**

9 The chief administrative officer of the Fulton County Juvenile Court shall have oversight of
10 the court's budget. After county funds have been appropriated for the operation of the court,
11 the chief administrative officer, with the approval of the chief judge of the juvenile court,
12 shall have the authority to make changes to line item appropriations.

13 **SECTION 2.**

14 The Fulton County Finance Department shall make all payroll adjustments related to
15 appointment, transfer, termination, or other personnel action requiring payroll adjustment
16 upon written notification by the chief administrative officer.

17 **SECTION 3.**

18 Any unexpended county appropriated funds remaining with the court at the end of a fiscal
19 year shall lapse to the general fund of Fulton County.

20 **SECTION 4.**

21 This Act shall become effective upon its approval by the Governor or upon its becoming law
22 without such approval.

SECTION 5.

24 All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are repealed.
