

House Bill 709 (AS PASSED HOUSE AND SENATE)

A BILL TO BE ENTITLED
AN ACT

1 To provide that future elections for the office of coroner of Terrell County shall be
2 nonpartisan elections; to provide for related matters; to repeal conflicting laws; and for other
3 purposes.

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

5 style="text-align:center">**SECTION 1.**

6 All elections for the office of coroner of Terrell County conducted after January 1, 2015,
7 shall be nonpartisan elections as provided for in Code Section 21-2-139 of the O.C.G.A.
8 Such nonpartisan elections shall be held in conjunction with the November general election
9 immediately preceding expiration of the term of office and conducted as provided in
10 Chapter 2 of Title 21 of the O.C.G.A., the "Georgia Election Code."

11 style="text-align:center">**SECTION 2.**

12 Nothing in this Act shall affect the term of office of the coroner of Terrell County in office
13 on January 1, 2015. The sitting coroner shall serve out the term of office for which he or she
14 was elected and shall be eligible to succeed himself or herself as provided in this Act.

16 All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are repealed.
