

House Bill 835 (AS PASSED HOUSE AND SENATE)

A BILL TO BE ENTITLED
AN ACT

1 To amend Chapter 13 of Title 16 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to
2 controlled substances, so as to change certain provisions relating to Schedules I, III, and IV
3 controlled substances; to change certain provisions relating to the definition of "dangerous
4 drug"; to provide for an effective date; to repeal conflicting laws; and for other purposes.

5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

6 style="text-align:center">**SECTION 1.**

7 Chapter 13 of Title 16 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to controlled
8 substances, is amended by adding new subparagraphs to paragraph (3) of Code Section
9 16-13-25, relating to Schedule I controlled substances, to read as follows:

10 "(NNN) 2-(2,5-dimethoxy-4-ethylphenyl)ethanamine (2C-E);
11 (OOO) 2-(2,5-Dimethoxy-4-nitrophenyl)-N-(2-methoxybenzyl)ethanamine
12 (25N-NBOMe);
13 (PPP) 4-acetoxy-N-ethyl-N-methyltryptamine (4-AcO-MET);
14 (QQQ) 4-nitro-2,5-dimethoxyphenethylamine (2C-N);
15 (RRR) 5-methoxy-N,N-methylisopropyltryptamine (5-MeO-MIPT);
16 (SSS) Methoxetamine;
17 (TTT) N-acetyl-3,4-methylenedioxymethcathinone;"

19 Said chapter is further amended by adding a new subparagraph to paragraph (4) of Code
20 Section 16-13-25, relating to Schedule I controlled substances, to read as follows:

21 "(D) Para-methoxyphenylpiperazine (MeOPP);"

23 Said chapter is further amended by adding new subparagraphs to paragraph (12) of Code
24 Section 16-13-25, relating to Schedule I controlled substances, to read as follows:

- 25 “(T) 1-(5-fluoropentyl)-N-(tricyclo[3.3.1.1^{3,7}]dec-1-yl)-1H-indole-3-carboxamide
26 (STS-135); or
27 (U) 1-naphthalenyl[4-(pentylox)-1-naphthalenyl]-methanone (CB-13);
28 (V) N-1-naphthalenyl-1-pentyl-1H-indole-3-carboxamide (NNEI);
29 (W) N-(1-amino-3,3-dimethyl-1-oxobutan-2-yl)-1-pentyl-1H-indole-3-carboxamide
30 (ADBICA);
31 (X) (1-(5-fluoropentyl)-1H-benzo[d]imidazol-2-yl)(naphthalen-1-yl)methanone
32 (AM-2201 benzimidazole analog);
33 (Y) Quinolin-8-yl-1-(4-fluorobenzyl)-1H-indole-3-carboxylate (FUB-PB-22);
34 (Z) Naphthalen-1-yl-1-(4-fluorobenzyl)-1H-indole-3-carboxylate (FDU-PB-22).”

35 **SECTION 4.**

36 Said chapter is further amended in Code Section 16-13-27, relating to Schedule III controlled
37 substances, by replacing the period with a semicolon at the end of paragraph (12) and by
38 adding a new paragraph to read as follows:

39 “(13) Perampanel and its salts, isomers, and salts of isomers.”

40 **SECTION 5.**

41 Said chapter is further amended by adding new paragraphs to subsection (a) of Code Section
42 16-13-28, relating to Schedule IV controlled substances, to read as follows:

43 “(17.5) Lorcaserin;”

44 “(31.5) Tramadol [2-((dimethylamino)methyl)-1-(3-methoxyphenyl)cyclohexanol, its
45 salts, optical and geometric isomers, and salts of these isomers].”

46 **SECTION 6.**

47 Said chapter is further amended in Code Section 16-13-71, relating to the definition of a
48 dangerous drug, by revising paragraphs (322) and (349.7) of subsection (b) and by adding
49 new paragraphs to subsection (b) to read as follows:

50 “(16.5) Ado-trastuzumab;”

51 “(17.1) Afatinib;”

52 “(22.3) Alogliptin;”

53 “(77.3) Bazedoxifene;”

54 “(130.1) Canagliflozin;”

55 “(235.7) Dabrafenib;”

56 “(291.5) Dimethyl fumarate;”

57 “(316.4) Dolutegravir;”

58 “(322) Doxylamine Reserved;”

- 59 "(349.3) Eslicarbazepine;"
 60 "(349.7) Esomeprazole – See exceptions;"
 61 "(402.6) Flutemetamol F18;"

80 **SECTION 7.**

- 81 Said chapter is further amended by adding a new paragraph to subsection (c) of Code Section
 82 16-13-71, relating to the definition of a dangerous drug, to read as follows:
 83 "(9.4) Esomeprazole – when a single dosage unit is 20 mg. or less;"

84 **SECTION 8.**

- 85 This Act shall become effective upon its approval by the Governor or upon its becoming law
 86 without such approval.

87 **SECTION 9.**

- 88 All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are repealed.
