## A RESOLUTION

1 Recognizing Mr. Harry Mixon and Mr. Brad Dorminy and naming a building in their honor;  
2 and for other purposes.

3 WHEREAS, a building on the campus of Wiregrass Georgia Technical College is currently  
4 named Irwin Hall; and

5 WHEREAS, the members of this body desire to rename this building as Dorminy-Mixon  
6 Hall in honor of Mr. Harry Mixon and Mr. Brad Dorminy.

7 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED AND ENACTED BY THE GENERAL  
8 ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA that the building currently named Irwin Hall on the campus of  
9 Wiregrass Georgia Technical College is renamed Dorminy-Mixon Hall.

10 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Technical College System of Georgia is authorized  
11 to erect and maintain appropriate signs naming Dorminy-Mixon Hall on the Wiregrass  
12 Georgia Technical College campus.

13 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Clerk of the House of Representatives is authorized  
14 and directed to make appropriate copies of this resolution available for distribution to Mr.  
15 Paul V. Liles, Jr., and to the Technical College System of Georgia.
