- WHEREAS: We derive confidence in the construction of Georgia's buildings thanks to building safety code enforcement personnel, such as: building safety and fire prevention officials, architects, engineers, builders, laborers, and others in the construction industry. These professionals play a vital role in ensuring the safety of our critical infrastructure; and
- WHEREAS: Construction codes provide safeguards to protect us from dangerous situations, such as snowstorms in the North, hurricanes in the Southeast, tornadoes in the Midwest, forest fires in the Southwest, and earthquakes on the West Coast. As a result, construction codes enhance the safety and security of our nation's citizens; and
- WHEREAS: "Building Safety Month: Code Officials Keep You Safe" is the theme for Building Safety Month 2013 and encourages all Georgians and Americans to raise awareness of the importance of building safety and to take the appropriate steps to ensure the places we live, learn, work, worship, and play are safe and sustainable; now
- THEREFORE: I, NATHAN DEAL, Governor of the State of Georgia, do hereby proclaim May 2013, as BUILDING SAFETY MONTH in Georgia and encourage residents to participate in Building Safety Month activities and efforts to improve building safety at home and in the community.
