expensive medical procedures, is becoming a major force in

moderating overall health care costs; and

WHEREAS:

Today's powerful medications require greater attention to the

manner in which they are used by different patient population

groups - both clinically and demographically; and

WHEREAS:

It is important that all users and caregivers of prescription or nonprescription medications be knowledgeable about and share

responsibility for their own drug therapy. The American Pharmacists Association and the Georgia Pharmacy Association join together in promoting October as American Pharmacists Month - with this
