EXECUTIVE ORDER

BY THE GOVERNOR:

FLAGS ON ALL STATE BUILDINGS AND GROUNDS ORDERED TO FLY AT HALF-STAFF

- WHEREAS: The Honorable Jack Hill of Reidsville, Georgia passed away on Monday, April 6, 2020; and
- **WHEREAS:** Senator Hill represented District 4 in the Georgia State Senate for 30 years. Most recently he served as the chairman of the Senate Appropriations Committee, vice chairman of the Senate Rules Committee; and
- WHEREAS: In addition to his extraordinary service in the Georgia State Senate, Senator Hill spent 37 years in the military. For 33 years he served in the Georgia Air National Guard, and in 2004 retired from the United States Air Force Reserve as a Reserve Forces Officer assigned to the Selective Service System; and
- **WHEREAS:** It is fitting and proper to remember and honor Senator Hill for his dedicated service to the State of Georgia and the United States of America.

Now, therefore, in honor and memory of the Honorable Jack Hill, pursuant to the authority vested in me as Governor of the state of Georgia, it is hereby

ORDERED: That the flag of the United States and the flag of the state of Georgia be flown at half-staff on all state buildings and grounds on Friday, April 10, 2020, the day of Senator Hill's interment.
