EXECUTIVE ORDER

BY THE GOVERNOR:

WHEREAS: The State of Georgia leases approximately 62 acres of improved real property (hereinafter the "Property") located at 2910 Newton Road, Albany, Dougherty County, Georgia, from Dougherty County pursuant to a Ninety-Nine-year lease which commenced January 25, 1939, which lease is recorded with the State Properties Commission Real Property Records as RPR# 002868; and

WHEREAS: Said Property is in the custody of the Georgia Forestry Commission; and

WHEREAS: The Property is improved with an office/shop building (BLLIP ID # 36257) which was constructed by the Georgia Forestry Commission in 1963 and is shown in the aerial photograph attached hereto as Exhibit "A" ("Structure"); and

WHEREAS: Said Structure is no longer in use and has been identified by the Georgia Forestry Commission as a liability to the agency due to cracks in the foundation and outdated electrical systems; and

WHEREAS: By Resolution dated February 11, 2020, the Georgia Forestry Commission requested authorization to demolish the Structure.

NOW, THEREFORE, PURSUANT TO THE AUTHORITY VESTED IN ME AS GOVERNOR OF THE STATE OF GEORGIA, IT IS HEREBY

ORDERED: The Georgia Forestry Commission is authorized and directed to provide for the razing, demolition and disposal of said Structure under the terms and conditions which are deemed to be in the best interest of the State of Georgia.
