EXECUTIVE ORDER

BY THE GOVERNOR:

- WHEREAS:** The Governor, on the recommendation of the Adjutant General, shall appoint an individual to serve as the State Judge Advocate (O.C.G.A. § 38-2-1006(a)); and
- WHEREAS:** The officer so appointed as State Judge Advocate shall be a judge advocate, a member of the State Bar of Georgia in good standing for not less than ten years, and have not less than five years of continuous service in the Army or Air National Guard of this state (O.C.G.A § 38-2-1006(a)); and
- WHEREAS:** The Adjutant General, Major General Thomas M. Carden, Jr., has recommended the appointment of Lieutenant Colonel Brian Scott Bischoff of Fayette County, Georgia, as State Judge Advocate; and
- WHEREAS:** Lieutenant Colonel Bischoff is a judge advocate, has been a member of the bar of the Supreme Court of this state and admitted to the bar of this state continuously and in good standing since 2000, and has been a member of the Georgia Army National Guard continuously since 2002.

NOW, THEREFORE, PURSUANT TO THE AUTHORITY VESTED IN ME AS GOVERNOR OF THE STATE OF GEORGIA, IT IS HEREBY

- ORDERED:** That Lieutenant Colonel Brian Scott Bischoff of Fayette County, Georgia, is hereby appointed State Judge Advocate (O.C.G.A. § 38-2-1006(a)) and any executive orders to the contrary are hereby revoked.
