BY THE GOVERNOR:

FLAGS ON STATE BUILDINGS AND GROUNDS ORDERED LOWERED TO HALF-STAFF

WHEREAS: On Friday, July 17, 2020, Georgia lost a true titan, Congressman

> John Robert Lewis – an American hero, civil rights icon, freedom fighter, and beloved Georgian - following his fierce battle with

WHEREAS: Throughout his life, John Lewis fought oppression, battled hatred,

and stood against intolerance with integrity and iron resolve; and

WHEREAS: John Lewis placed the lives of his fellow Americans above his own -

risking his all for the cause of freedom and equality; and

the principles he embodied to forge a stronger, brighter future for the

generations of Georgians and Americans to come.

NOW, THEREFORE, IN HONOR OF AND AS A MARK OF RESPECT FOR THE MEMORY OF JOHN ROBERT LEWIS, PURSUANT TO THE

AUTHORITY VESTED IN ME AS GOVERNOR OF THE STATE OF

GEORGIA, IT IS HEREBY

That the flag of the United States of America and the flag of the State ORDERED:

> of Georgia shall be flown at half-staff on all state buildings and grounds from the date of this order through sunset on the day of his

interment.
