



# THE STATE OF GEORGIA

## EXECUTIVE ORDER

BY THE GOVERNOR:

- WHEREAS:** The State of Georgia holds title to approximately 1,480 acres of improved real property (hereinafter the "Property") located at 46 John Coffee Road, located in Land Lot 329, 6th District, City of Nicholls, Coffee County, Georgia, acquired by virtue of a deed dated May 28, 1970, recorded in Deed Book 168, pages 191-195, in the office of the Clerk of Superior Court of Coffee County, and filed with the State Properties Commission, Real Property Record as RPR# 004193; and
- WHEREAS:** Said Property is in the custody of the Georgia Department of Natural Resources and is operated as General Coffee State Park; and
- WHEREAS:** The Property is improved with a building known as the Pool House (BLLIP ID # 26764) as shown in the aerial photograph attached hereto as Exhibit A (hereinafter the "Structure"); and
- WHEREAS:** Said Structure is beyond reasonable repair and no longer needed since the pool has been filled; and
- WHEREAS:** By Resolution dated August 25, 2020, the Georgia Department of Natural Resources requested authority to demolish the Structure.

**NOW, THEREFORE, PURSUANT TO THE AUTHORITY VESTED IN ME AS GOVERNOR OF THE STATE OF GEORGIA, IT IS HEREBY**

**ORDERED:** The Georgia Department of Natural Resources is authorized and directed to provide for the razing, demolition and disposal of said Structure under the terms and conditions which are deemed to be in the best interest of the State of Georgia.
