The first Tuesday of February has been officially designated as Firefighters WHEREAS:

Recognition Day in the State of Georgia; and

tirelessly to protect lives and property through fire response, medical

emergencies, fire prevention, and code enforcement; and

Firefighters are specially trained to assist in many other situations, including WHEREAS:

> vehicle accidents, utility emergencies, rescues involving specialized equipment, building collapses, water main breaks, hazardous material incidents, and other

non-fire emergencies; and

To keep our communities safe, firefighters also offer fire safety education and WHEREAS:

prevention strategies to the general public; and

ensure the safety and well-being of Georgia's citizens; now
