WHEREAS: On February, 29, 2020, the City of Atlanta will welcome the nation's best

runners to the U.S. Olympic Team Trials Marathon - a competition for a spot

on Team USA at the 2020 Summer Olympics in Tokyo, Japan; and

15,000 dedicated runners and walkers along with 2,000 volunteers will WHEREAS:

participate in the Publix Atlanta Marathon, Half Marathon, and 5K on March 1,

2020; and

WHEREAS: Spectators, fans, friends, and family from Georgia and across the U.S. will line

the streets of Running City USA to witness a weekend dedicated to the Atlanta

Track Club's vision of a healthier city through running and walking; and

WHEREAS: This incredible event lends Atlanta an opportunity to showcase its Olympic

legacy as participants pass Centennial Olympic Park, the former Olympic

Stadium, and the Olympic Ring and Cauldron structure; and

WHEREAS: During America's Marathon Weekend, Atlanta will make history by crowning

the first Olympians of the 2020 Summer Olympic Games and further inspire

the Olympic dreams of the next generation; now
