dedicated to promoting and encouraging Georgia's youth to adopt good oral health habits. The organization and program have provided educational expertunities and dental expensions for school shildren since 1050; and

opportunities and dental screenings for school children since 1950; and

WHEREAS: GDA's annual "Give Kids A Smile Program" helps educate, assess, and improve

the oral health of one of Georgia's most vulnerable populations; and

WHEREAS: Children's Dental Health Month provides an important opportunity to raise
