GEORGIA SCHOOL CHOICE WEEK

WHEREAS: Each child in Georgia has the right to a high-quality education. By increasing

access to high-performing schools and improving education outcomes, we can ensure the continued growth and development of our state's most valuable

resources – the minds of our youngest learners; and

WHEREAS: To equip Georgia's children with the right tools for success and prepare them

as our next generation of leaders, we must empower families with the ability to

choose the best educational environment for their children; and

WHEREAS: School choice allows families to evaluate the specific needs and unique traits of

their children and leverage the option that best serves their educational experience, be it through public, charter, home-based, private, magnet, or

online-schooling; and

WHEREAS: In schools across the state, teaching professionals are committed to providing

our children with the knowledge and skills needed to meet the challenges of

today and tomorrow; and

WHEREAS: Research indicates that increasing access to multiple schooling options improves

the academic performance of children, regardless of income level, geography, or

academic ability; and

WHEREAS: School Choice Week is recognized by millions of students, parents, educators,

schools, and community leaders across the nation, and it presents a unique opportunity to raise awareness of the importance of an effective education system in providing students with greater opportunities for academic

achievement; now

THEREFORE: I, BRIAN P. KEMP, Governor of the State of Georgia, do hereby proclaim

January 27-31, 2020 as GEORGIA SCHOOL CHOICE WEEK in Georgia.
