and grow as individuals; and

WHEREAS: DECAL has partnered with local school systems in Georgia to create and

support 181 inclusion classrooms in Georgia's Pre-K Program and has developed resources and a network of professionals within the department to

help teachers meet the needs of every child in their care; and

WHEREAS: DECAL's efforts have contributed significantly to the empowerment and

capacity of programs, providers, families, and communities to support children

with disabilities in high quality inclusive environments in Georgia; and

WHEREAS: During Inclusive Early Learning Week and throughout the year, DECAL will

support early learning professionals, administrators, stakeholders, and families in focusing awareness to ensure that all children, including those with

disabilities, have high quality early learning environments; now
