6 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

7 **SECTION 1.** 8 Article 7 of Chapter 4 of Title 49 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to medical assistance generally, is amended by adding a new Code section to read as follows: 9 10 ″<u>49-4-159.</u> 11 (a) The department shall provide Medicaid coverage for: 12 (1) Lactation care and services, as defined in paragraph (5) of Code Section 43-22A-3, 13 to pregnant and lactating women and to children who are breastfeeding or receiving their 14 mother's milk; and 15 (2) Postpartum care for mothers for a period of six months following the date the woman 16 gives birth. 17 (b) If necessary to implement the provisions of this Code section, the department shall submit a Medicaid state plan amendment or waiver request to the United States Department 18 of Health and Human Services." 19 20 **SECTION 2.** This Act shall become effective only upon the effective date of a specific appropriation of 21

22 funds for purposes of this Act, as expressed in a line item making specific reference to such

23 Act in a General Appropriations Act enacted by the General Assembly.

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25 All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are repealed.
