A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT

- 1 To authorize the assessment and collection of a technology fee by the State Court of
- 2 Washington County; to identify the authorized uses of such technology fee; to provide for
- 3 the termination of such technology fee and dedication of residual funds to technology uses;
- 4 to provide for related matters; to repeal conflicting laws; and for other purposes.

5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

6 SECTION 1.

- 7 (a) The clerk of the State Court of Washington County is hereby authorized to charge and
- 8 collect a technology fee to be set by the judge of the state court in an amount not to
- 9 exceed \$5.00 for the filing of each civil action with the court and not to exceed \$5.00 as a
- 10 surcharge upon each fine assessed by the court. Such technology fees shall be used
- exclusively to provide for technological needs of the office of the Sheriff of Washington
- 12 County. Such uses shall include the:
- 13 (1) Purchase of computer hardware and software;
- 14 (2) Leasing, maintenance, and installation of computer hardware; and
- 15 (3) Purchase, leasing, maintenance, and installation of imaging, scanning, facsimile,
- 16 communications, projection, and printing equipment and software.
- 17 (b) Funds collected pursuant to this section shall be maintained in a segregated account by
- 18 the clerk of the state court and shall be used only for the purposes authorized in this section.
- 19 (c) The authority to assess a technology fee pursuant to this section shall terminate on
- 20 July 1, 2030, and any residual funds remaining in the fund established by this section shall
- 21 remain dedicated to general Washington County technology uses.

SECTION 2.

23 All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are repealed.
