

House Bill 1181 (AS PASSED HOUSE AND SENATE)

A BILL TO BE ENTITLED
AN ACT

1 To amend an Act to fix the compensation of the members of the Board of Education of
2 Johnson County, approved April 6, 1992 (Ga. L. 1992, p. 5425), as amended, particularly by
3 an Act approved March 24, 1994 (Ga. L. 1994, p. 3722), so as to change the compensation
4 of the members of the board of education; to provide for related matters; to provide an
5 effective date; to repeal conflicting laws; and for other purposes.

6 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

7 **SECTION 1.**

8 An Act to fix the compensation of the members of the Board of Education of Johnson
9 County, approved April 6, 1992 (Ga. L. 1992, p. 5425), as amended, particularly by an Act
10 approved March 24, 1994 (Ga. L. 1994, p. 3722), is amended by revising Section 1 as
11 follows:

12 "SECTION 1.

13 Each member of the Board of Education of Johnson County other than the chairman shall
14 receive a per diem of \$200.00, and the chairman of the board shall receive a per diem of
15 \$250.00, for each day of attendance at meetings of the board and while meeting and
16 traveling within or outside the state as a member of a committee of the board on official
17 business first authorized by a majority of the board, plus reimbursement for actual expenses
18 necessarily incurred in connection therewith. The accounts for such service and expenses
19 shall be submitted for approval to the county school superintendent."

20 **SECTION 2.**

21 This Act shall become effective on the first day of the month following the month in which
22 such Act is approved by the Governor or in which it becomes law without such approval.

SECTION 3.

24 All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are repealed.
