

House Bill 1189 (AS PASSED HOUSE AND SENATE)

A BILL TO BE ENTITLED
AN ACT

1 To repeal an Act creating the Hall County Commission for Children and Families, approved
2 April 23, 1999 (Ga. L. 1999, p. 4874); to provide for the assets and liabilities thereof; to
3 repeal conflicting laws; and for other purposes.

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

5 **SECTION 1.**

6 An Act creating the Hall County Commission for Children and Families, approved
7 April 23, 1999 (Ga. L. 1999, p. 4874), is hereby repealed in its entirety.

8 **SECTION 2.**

9 There are no known assets of the Hall County Commission for Children and Families, but
10 to the extent any assets of the Hall County Commission for Children and Families exist, they
11 shall devolve automatically and without further action to Hall County, Georgia. The Board
12 of Commissioners of Hall County, Georgia, is authorized to execute any deeds or instruments
13 of conveyance required to place title of such assets into the name of Hall County and is
14 authorized to do so in the name of the Hall County Commission for Children and Families.
15 There are no known obligations of the Hall County Commission for Children and Families,
16 but to the extent such obligations exist, they shall be transferred to and assumed by Hall
17 County, Georgia, by such instruments as may be required to maintain the same. The Board
18 of Commissioners of Hall County, Georgia, is authorized to execute any such instruments
19 required to transfer such obligations into the name of Hall County and is authorized to do so
20 in the name of the Hall County Commission for Children and Families.

21 **SECTION 3.**

22 All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are repealed.
