A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT

- 1 To amend Part 1 of Article 3 of Chapter 1 of Title 40 of the Official Code of Georgia
- 2 Annotated, relating to the "Georgia Motor Carrier Act of 2012," so as to prohibit the
- 3 consideration of the deployment of motor carrier safety improvements in determining an
- 4 individual's employment status with a motor carrier; to provide for a definition; to provide
- 5 for related matters; to repeal conflicting laws; and for other purposes.

6 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

7 SECTION 1.

- 8 Part 1 of Article 3 of Chapter 1 of Title 40 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated,
- 9 relating to the "Georgia Motor Carrier Act of 2012," is amended by adding a new Code
- 10 section to read as follows:
- 11 "<u>40-1-58.</u>
- 12 (a) For purposes of this Code section, the term 'motor carrier safety improvement' means
- any device, equipment, software, technology, procedure, training, policy, program, or
- 14 operational practice intended and primarily used to improve or facilitate compliance with
- traffic safety or motor carrier safety laws, safety of a motor vehicle, safety of the operator
- of a motor vehicle, or safety of third-party users of highways of this state.
- 17 (b) The deployment, implementation, or use of a motor carrier safety improvement by or
- as required by a motor carrier or its related entity, including by contract, shall not be
- 19 <u>considered when evaluating an individual's status as an employee or independent</u>
- 20 contractor, or as a jointly employed employee, under any state law."

21 SECTION 2.

22 All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are repealed.
