A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT

- 1 To amend Title 40 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to motor vehicles and
- 2 traffic, so as to provide for standards for issuance of a Georgia certificate of title for certain
- 3 motor vehicles converted from original manufacturer condition in order to comply with
- 4 certain state and federal requirements; to provide for exceptions to certain federal standards
- 5 for such motor vehicles; to provide for definitions; to provide for related matters; to repeal
- 6 conflicting laws; and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

8 SECTION 1.

- 9 Title 40 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to motor vehicles and traffic, is
- amended in Code Section 40-1-1, relating to definitions, by revising paragraph (25.1) as
- 11 follows:

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- 12 "(25.1) 'Low-speed vehicle' means any four-wheeled electric vehicle whose top speed
- 13 attainable in one mile is greater than 20 miles per hour but not greater than 25 miles per
- hour on a paved level surface and which is manufactured or converted to comply in
- compliance with standards based upon those federal motor vehicle safety standards for
- low-speed vehicles set forth in 49 C.F.R. Section 571.500, as amended and in effect on
- 17 January 1, 2001."
- 18 SECTION 2.
- 19 Said title is further amended in Code Section 40-2-27, relating to registration of motor
- 20 vehicles not manufactured to comply with federal emission and safety standards, certificate
- 21 of registration for an assembled motor vehicle or motorcycle, and former military motor
- vehicles, by revising subsection (d) as follows:
- 23 "(d)(1) Before a certificate of registration is issued for an assembled motor vehicle or
- 24 motorcycle <u>as such term is defined in Code Section 40-3-30.1</u>, such assembled motor

vehicle or motorcycle shall have been issued a certificate of title in Georgia and shall

- comply with the provisions of <u>such</u> Code Section 40-3-30.1 <u>section</u>.
- 27 (2) Before a certificate of registration is issued for a converted motor vehicle as such
- 28 <u>term is defined in Code Section 40-3-30.1, such converted motor vehicle shall have been</u>
- 29 <u>issued a certificate of title in Georgia upon compliance with the inspection provisions of</u>
- 30 <u>Code Section 40-3-30.1."</u>
- 31 SECTION 3.
- 32 Said title is further amended in Code Section 40-3-30, relating to requirement of compliance
- 33 with federal safety standards, by adding a new subsection to read as follows:
- 34 "(d) The provisions of subsection (a) of this Code section shall not apply to applications
- 35 for certificates of title for converted motor vehicles as such term is defined in Code Section
- 36 <u>40-3-30.1.</u>"
- SECTION 4.
- 38 Said title is further amended by revising Code Section 40-3-30.1, relating to inspections of
- 39 assembled motor vehicles and motorcycles, as follows:
- 40 "40-3-30.1.
- 41 (a) As used in this Code section and in Code Section 40-2-27, the term:
- 42 (1) 'Assembled motor vehicle or motorcycle' or 'kit motor vehicle or motorcycle' means
- any motor vehicle or motorcycle that is:
- 44 (A) Manufactured from a manufacturer's kit or manufacturer's fabricated parts,
- 45 including replicas and original designs:
- 46 (i)(I) By an owner; or
- 47 (ii)(II) At the request of the owner by a third-party manufacturer of motor vehicles
- 48 or motorcycles; and
- 49 (iii)(i) Such owner or third-party manufacturer is not manufacturing and testing
- in accordance with federal safety standards issued pursuant to 49 U.S.C.A. Section
- 51 30101, et seq., unless; and until the
- 52 (II) The United States Customs Service or the United States Department of
- Transportation has <u>not</u> certified that the motor vehicle complies with such
- 54 applicable federal standards;
- (B) A new vehicle and consists of a prefabricated body, chassis, and drive train;
- 56 (C) Handmade and not mass produced by any manufacturer for retail sale; or
- 57 (D) Not otherwise excluded from emission requirements and is in compliance with
- 58 Chapter 8 of Title 40, relating to equipment and inspection of motor vehicles.

(2) 'Converted motor vehicle' means any unconventional motor vehicle that has been
 altered from the original manufactured condition by an owner or third party in order to
 comply with certain state and federal requirements relating to low-speed vehicles.

- (3)(A) 'Unconventional motor vehicle or motorcycle' means any motor vehicle or motorcycle that is <u>not</u> manufactured, <u>including</u>, <u>but not limited to</u>, <u>all-terrain vehicles</u>, <u>off-road vehicles</u>, <u>motor driven cycles</u>, <u>mopeds</u>, <u>and personal transportation vehicles</u>, <u>and that is not</u> in compliance with the following:
 - (i) Chapter 8 of Title 40, relating to equipment and inspection of motor vehicles;
- (ii) Applicable federal motor vehicle safety standards issued pursuant to 49 U.S.C.A.
- Section 30101, et seq., unless and until the United States Customs and Border
- Protection Agency or the United States Department of Transportation has certified
- that the motor vehicle complies with such applicable federal standards; or
- 71 (iii) Applicable federal emission standards issued pursuant to 42 U.S.C.A. Section
- 72 7401 through Section 7642, the 'Clean Air Act,' as amended.
- 73 (B) Such term shall not include former military motor vehicles.
- 74 (b) In addition to the requirements contained in Code Section 40-3-30, prior to the
- issuance of a certificate of title to the owner of an assembled motor vehicle or motorcycle,
- the owner shall cause such assembled motor vehicle or motorcycle to be inspected in order
- 77 to establish:

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- 78 (1) The existence of a verifiable Manufacturer's Certificate of Origin (MCO) or other
- verifiable documentation of purchase of all major components; and
- 80 (2) That such assembled motor vehicle or motorcycle complies with:
 - (A) Chapter 8 of Title 40, relating to equipment and inspection of motor vehicles; and
- 82 (B) If applicable, federal emission standards issued pursuant to 42 U.S.C.A. Section
- 7401 through Section 7642, the 'Clean Air Act,' as amended.
- 84 (c) Prior to the issuance of a certificate of title to the owner of a converted motor vehicle,
- 85 the owner shall cause such converted motor vehicle to be inspected in order to establish
- 86 <u>that such vehicle complies with:</u>
- 87 (1) Chapter 8 of Title 40, relating to equipment and inspection of motor vehicles; and
- 88 (2) Standards for low-speed vehicles based upon applicable standards set forth in 49
- 89 <u>C.F.R. Section 571.500, as amended.</u>
- 90 (d) The inspection inspections conducted under subsection (b) and subsection (c) of this
- Code section shall only be for the purpose of establishing that such assembled inspected
- motor vehicle or motorcycle is eligible to receive a certificate of title.
- 93 (d)(e) The department shall be authorized to charge an inspection fee.
- 94 (e)(f) Unconventional motor vehicles or motorcycles shall not be titled or registered."
