## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT

- 1 To amend Article 3 of Chapter 2 of Title 32 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated,
- 2 relating to officers in the Department of Transportation, so as to provide for state investment
- 3 in railways and railroad facilities and equipment; to provide for a definition; to provide that
- 4 the commissioner of transportation may administer a Georgia Freight Railroad Program; to
- 5 provide for subprograms within such program; to provide for annual reporting; to provide
- 6 for standards for expenditure of funds; to provide for related matters; to repeal conflicting
- 7 laws; and for other purposes.

## BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

9 **SECTION 1.** 

- 10 Article 3 of Chapter 2 of Title 32 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to
- officers in the Department of Transportation, is amended by adding a new Code section to
- read as follows:

- 14 (a) For purposes of this Code section, the term 'short line railway' means any carrier
- designated as a Class III by the Surface Transportation Board.
- 16 (b) The Georgia Freight Railroad Program shall be administered, subject to appropriations,
- 17 <u>at the discretion of the commissioner, in order to enhance the state's investment in freight</u>
- 18 <u>rail projects for public benefit and to support a safe and balanced transportation system for</u>
- 19 the state.
- 20 (c) Eligible projects under the Georgia Freight Railroad Program shall include rail
- 21 <u>enhancement projects to acquire, lease, or improve railways or railroad equipment,</u>
- 22 <u>including rail crossings</u>, rolling stock, rights of way, or rail facilities; rail preservation
- 23 projects to acquire, lease, or improve short line railways or assist other appropriate entities
- 24 to acquire, lease, or improve short line railways; and rail industrial projects to build,
- 25 <u>construct, restructure, or improve industrial access to railroad tracks and related facilities.</u>

(d) In administering the program, the commissioner shall make every effort to balance
 such program among all regions of this state and among the various applicants.

- (e) Following the end of each fiscal year, the commissioner or his or her designee shall
   submit an annual report on the activities of the Georgia Freight Railroad Program to the
- 30 Governor, the Lieutenant Governor, and the Speaker of the House of Representatives and
- 31 <u>shall make such report available to the members of the General Assembly.</u>
- 32 (f) Prior to the expenditure of state funds, the commissioner shall make a determination
- 33 whether such expenditure is ample consideration for a substantial public benefit in
- 34 compliance with Article III, Section VI, Paragraph VI (a) of the Georgia Constitution."

35 SECTION 2.

36 All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are repealed.
