EXECUTIVE ORDER

BY THE GOVERNOR:

FLAGS ON STATE BUILDINGS AND GROUNDS ORDERED LOWERED TO HALF STAFF

WHEREAS: It is appropriate to honor the lives of United States Capitol Police Officers Brian Sicknick and Howard Liebengood who were on duty at the United States Capitol on Wednesday, January 6, 2021; and

WHEREAS: The people of Georgia share the grief of the families and friends of those who passed away, and we pray for their comfort and healing in the days to come; and

WHEREAS: The President of the United States has ordered that the flag of the United States be flown at half-staff on government buildings and grounds.

NOW, THEREFORE, IN HONOR AND AS A MARK OF RESPECT FOR THOSE AFFECTED BY THIS TRAGEDY, PURSUANT TO THE AUTHORITY VESTED IN ME AS GOVERNOR OF THE STATE OF GEORGIA, IT IS HEREBY

ORDERED: That the flag of the United States and the flag of the State of Georgia shall be flown at half-staff on all state buildings and grounds on Wednesday, January 13, 2021, until sunset.
