## EXECUTIVE ORDER

## BY THE GOVERNOR:

## FLAGS ON STATE BUILDINGS AND GROUNDS ORDERED LOWERED TO HALF-STAFF

WHEREAS: On Friday, January 22, 2021, Georgia lost one of its greatest legends

and American icon, Henry Louis "Hank" Aaron; and

WHEREAS: Hank Aaron's life and career made history, and his influence was felt

not only in the world of sports, but far beyond – through his important work to advance civil rights and create a more equal, just

society; and

**WHEREAS:** As we mourn his death, we must honor his legacy by striving toward

the principles he embodied to forge a stronger, brighter future for the

generations of Georgians and Americans to come.

Now, therefore, in honor of and as a mark of respect for the memory of Henry Louis "Hank" Aaron, pursuant to the authority vested in me as Governor of the State of

GEORGIA, IT IS HEREBY

**Ordered:** That the flag of the United States of America and the flag of the State

of Georgia shall be flown at half-staff on all state buildings and

grounds from this day until sunset on the day of his funeral.
