EXECUTIVE ORDER

BY THE GOVERNOR:

WHEREAS: On February 10, 2021, Fani T. Willis, Fulton County District Attorney provided notice that she had “opened an investigation into attempts to influence the administration of the 2020 Georgia General Election”; and

WHEREAS: The Attorney General has declined representation of the Secretary of State in this matter; and

WHEREAS: Mr. Jack Sharman is an attorney duly admitted to the State Bar of Georgia; and

WHEREAS: Mr. Jack Sharman has agreed to represent the Office of the Secretary of State in this investigation at a rate mutually agreed upon by the Secretary of State and Mr. Sharman.

NOW, THEREFORE, PURSUANT TO O.C.G.A. § 45-15-70 AND THE AUTHORITY VESTED IN ME AS GOVERNOR OF THE STATE OF GEORGIA, IT IS HEREBY

ORDERED: That Mr. Jack Sharman of Lightfoot, Franklin & White LLC is hereby appointed as Special Counsel to assume control and responsibility for the representation of the Office of the Secretary of State in all matters related to District Attorney Willis’ investigation.
