EXECUTIVE ORDER

BY THE GOVERNOR:

WHEREAS: On September 9, 2021, Tatyana and Troy Ellis filed a Verified Petition for Writ of Mandamus in case number 2021-0118399-CV against Senior Judge Adele Grubbs in the Superior Court of Cobb County; and

WHEREAS: The Georgia Department of Law has declined representation of the Honorable Adele Grubbs due to a potential conflict; and

WHEREAS: Mr. Robert Ingram, Mr. Ryan Ingram, and Mr. David Conley of Moore Ingram Johnson & Steele, LLP are all attorneys duly admitted to the State Bar of Georgia; and

WHEREAS: Mr. Robert Ingram, Mr. Ryan Ingram, and Mr. David Conley of Moore Ingram Johnson & Steele, LLP have agreed to represent Judge Adele Grubbs at a rate mutually agreed upon with the Office of the Governor.

NOW, THEREFORE, PURSUANT TO O.C.G.A. § 45-15-70 AND BY THE AUTHORITY VESTED IN ME AS GOVERNOR OF THE STATE OF GEORGIA, IT IS HEREBY

ORDERED: That Mr. Robert Ingram, Mr. Ryan Ingram, and Mr. David Conley of Moore Ingram Johnson & Steele, LLP are hereby appointed as Special Counsel to assume control and responsibility for the representation of the Honorable Adele Grubbs in all matters related to the Verified Petition for Writ of Mandamus filed against her in case number 2021-0118399-CV.
