## EXECUTIVE ORDER

---

BY THE GOVERNOR:

**WHEREAS:** On August 2, 2021, Mr. Royce Reeves, Ward 2 Commissioner on the Cordele City Commission, was indicted on two counts of Obstruction of an Officer, one count of Violation of Oath by a Public Officer, one count of Criminal Trespass, and one count of Disorderly Conduct; and

**WHEREAS:** On September 7, 2021, pursuant to O.C.G.A. § 45-5-6(b), an Executive Order was issued appointing members to a committee charged with determining whether the above-mentioned indictment relates to and adversely affects the administration of duties by Commissioner Reeves such that the rights and interests of the public are adversely affected thereby; and

**WHEREAS:** On October 15, 2021, pursuant to O.C.G.A. § 45-5-6(c), members of the review commission requested a 60-day extension for the commission to issue its report.

**NOW, THEREFORE, PURSUANT TO THE AUTHORITY VESTED IN ME AS GOVERNOR OF THE STATE OF GEORGIA, IT IS HEREBY**

**ORDERED:** That the extension for the review commission to issue its report in the matter of the indictment of Cordele City Commissioner Royce Reeves is hereby extended to Tuesday, December 14, 2021.
