EXECUTIVE ORDER

BY THE GOVERNOR:

FLAGS ON STATE CAPITOL BUILDING AND IN JACKSON COUNTY ORDERED LOWERED TO HALF-STAFF

WHEREAS:

Deputy Lena Nicole Marshall, with the Jackson County Sheriff's

Office, passed away on Monday, November 8, 2021, after being shot

in the line of duty on Friday, November 5, 2021; and

WHEREAS:

In addition to her service with the Jackson County Sheriff's Office, Deputy Marshall also served with the Winder Police Department, the Barrow County Sheriff's Office, the Helen Police Department, and

the Habersham County Sheriff's Office; and

WHEREAS:

It is fitting and proper to recognize Deputy Marshall's service to Jackson County and the State of Georgia by lowering the flags on the State Capitol building and in Jackson County to half-staff.

Now, therefore, in honor of and as a mark of respect for the memory of Deputy Lena Nicole Marshall, pursuant to the authority vested in me as Governor of the state of Georgia, it is hereby

ORDERED:

That the flag of the United States and the flag of the State of Georgia be flown at half-staff on the State Capitol building and in Jackson County on Monday, November 15, 2021, the day of Deputy Marshall's interment, until sunset.
