FLAGS ON STATE CAPITOL BUILDING AND IN CLAYTON COUNTY ORDERED LOWERED TO HALF-STAFF

WHEREAS: Clayton County Field Training Officer Henry Laxson, 27, passed

away on Tuesday, November 30, 2021, after being shot in the line of

duty; and

WHEREAS: Officer Laxson joined the Clayton County Police Department in 2017

where he served as a member of the Targeted Interdiction General

Enforcement Response unit and the SWAT team; and

WHEREAS: It is fitting and proper to recognize Officer Laxson's service to

Clayton County and the State of Georgia by lowering the flags on the

State Capitol building and in Clayton County to half-staff.

NOW, THEREFORE, IN HONOR OF AND AS A MARK OF RESPECT FOR THE MEMORY OF OFFICER HENRY LAXSON, PURSUANT TO THE

AUTHORITY VESTED IN ME AS GOVERNOR OF THE STATE OF

GEORGIA, IT IS HEREBY

Ordered: That the flag of the United States and the flag of the State of Georgia

be flown at half-staff on the State Capitol building and in Clayton County on Tuesday, December 7, 2021, the day of Officer Laxson's

interment, until sunset.
