## A PROCLAMATION

### 44<sup>TH</sup> ANNUAL NATIONAL NURSING ASSISTANTS' WEEK

- WHEREAS:** Nursing homes, home care, hospitals, and other long-term care agencies have accepted the responsibility for providing quality care and a quality of life for the elder, frail, and disabled citizens in our community; and
- WHEREAS:** The wellbeing and happiness of these citizens depend in large part on the nursing assistants, home care aides, patient care assistants, and others who provide 85 to 90 percent of the daily, hands-on care in nursing homes and other long-term care settings; and
- WHEREAS:** These career nursing assistants are instrumental in promoting and safeguarding the physical, mental, emotional, social, and spiritual well-being of the residents, clients, and their families; and
- WHEREAS:** Career nursing assistants are trained professionals who collaborate closely with other health care providers to provide quality care and to elevate the status of their chosen profession; now
- THEREFORE:** I, BRIAN P. KEMP, Governor of the State of Georgia, do hereby proclaim June 17-24, 2021, as the 44<sup>TH</sup> ANNUAL NATIONAL NURSING ASSISTANTS' WEEK in Georgia.
