A PROCLAMATION

AGRICULTURE DAY

- WHEREAS:** American agriculture builds on centuries of progress by constantly seeking advances in science, research, technology, production, and marketing to meet the demands of changing consumer needs and complex world markets; and
- WHEREAS:** America's food and agriculture sectors feed the economy and fuel the nation, contributing \$3.7 billion to Georgia exports; and
- WHEREAS:** The food and agriculture industries provide 1,403,318 jobs across the State of Georgia, including employment for farmers, farmworkers, scientists, processors, shippers, and retailers; and
- WHEREAS:** Stewardship by America's farmers and ranchers ensures a sustainable resource base for future generations; and
- WHEREAS:** American farmers and ranchers uphold the rural character of the nation as they provide the most abundant and most affordable food and fiber supply in the world; now
- THEREFORE:** I, BRIAN P. KEMP, Governor of the State of Georgia, do hereby proclaim March 23, 2021, as AGRICULTURE DAY in Georgia.
