- WHEREAS:** William Clyde “Chase” Elliott II has been recognized throughout the State of Georgia for the many years of sports entertainment he has provided and the many accomplishments he has achieved during his NASCAR career; and
- WHEREAS:** Chase began racing go-karts at eight years of age with the dream of one day competing at NASCAR’s highest level. From 2003 to 2011, he gained experience by competing in and winning more than sixty races, which led to him to sign a multi-year driving agreement with Hendrick Motorsports in 2011; and
- WHEREAS:** Since his initial agreement with Hendrick Motorsports, he has earned many awards for his driving excellence, including the 2014 NASCAR Xfinity Series Rookie of the Year, 2016 NASCAR Cup Series Rookie of the Year, and Autosport Top-50 Drivers in the World; and
- WHEREAS:** He achieved his dream of NASCAR competition by winning Watkins Glen in 2018, and he became the NASCAR Cup Series Champion in 2020; and
- WHEREAS:** It is abundantly fitting and proper that the outstanding accomplishments of this remarkable and distinguished Georgian be appropriately honored; now
- THEREFORE:** I, BRIAN P. KEMP, Governor of the State of Georgia, do hereby proclaim February 9, 2021 as CHASE ELLIOTT DAY in Georgia.
