WHEREAS: Community corrections professionals provide necessary services, support, and

WHEREAS: Through their advocacy for community and restorative justice community

corrections professionals are a true force for positive change in their

18-24, 2021 as COMMUNITY SUPERVISION WEEK in Georgia.
