WHEREAS: Economics is the study of making sound decisions in managing scarce resources,

WHEREAS: The aim of economic education is to equip students with skills and tools for their

economic roles as productive workers, informed consumers and savers, involved

citizens, and lifelong decision-makers in a globally interdependent world; and

WHEREAS: literate citizens who can understand and evaluate critical issues of public policy; Our democracy depends on the active support and involvement of economically

WHEREAS: Economic education must be established and maintained in our K-12 schools,

help them understand their economic world; and where even young children are capable of learning basic economic concepts that

WHEREAS: Economic education in our schools depends on K-12 educators equipped with

lessons that develop the skills necessary to make informed choices as citizens; high quality training and resources to ensure students have access to classroom

THEREFORE: I, BRIAN P. KEMP, Governor of the State of Georgia, do hereby proclaim October 2021 as ECONOMICS EDUCATION MONTH in Georgia.
