APROCLAMATION

EDUCATION AND SHARING DAY

WHEREAS: Excellence in education is instrumental in ensuring the continued growth and success of

our state and nation. In the great State of Georgia, we seek the betterment of all citizens

and look to instill each child and adolescent with a quality education; and

WHEREAS: By preparing our students for the responsibilities and opportunities of the future, education

encourages the adoption of ideals and ethics that equip and unite us in working toward a

bright future; and

WHEREAS: The Lubavitcher Rebbe, Rabbi Menachem Schneerson, a global spiritual leader who

dedicated his life to the betterment of mankind, was a tireless advocate for youth around the world. He emphasized the importance of education and good character, and instilled

hope into the lives of countless people in America and around the world; and

WHEREAS: The Rebbe taught that education should include the acquisition of knowledge and

preparation for a career to make a better living for oneself as well as for the society as a whole, and that the education system therefore must pay more attention to the building of

character, with emphasis on moral and ethical values; and

WHEREAS: In recognition of the Rebbe's lasting contributions toward improvements in world

education and acts of charity, the United States Congress established his birth date as a
