## **A PROCLAMATION**

## GEORGIA PREPAREDNESS MONTH

WHEREAS: Promoting a culture of resilience through preparedness helps enable communities and

individuals to take the preparatory actions necessary to overcome the threats and

hazards that present themselves; and

WHEREAS: Preparedness Month offers opportunities to prepare for emergencies such as natural

disasters, potential terrorist attacks, and public health threats; and

WHEREAS: To ensure appropriate preparedness, Georgians can create ready kits, obtain

homeowner's and flood insurance policies, start rainy-day funds, make a family disaster

plan, and stay informed of potential threats; and

WHEREAS: Each step Georgians take to become better prepared makes a real difference in how

our families and communities will respond and persevere when faced with the

unexpected; and

WHEREAS: The Georgia Office of Insurance and Safety Fire Commissioner recommends citizens

> periodically review their insurance policies as part of their emergency preparedness efforts and seek assistance in obtaining flood insurance to supplement their

homeowner's insurance policies where necessary; and

WHEREAS: Companies such as Anheuser-Busch continue to provide much-needed aid in disaster

> relief and preparedness efforts, including its flagship emergency drinking water program. In conjunction with the American Red Cross and its wholesaler partners, Anheuser-Busch have dedicated their production and logistics capabilities to help provide emergency drinking water to communities affected by natural disasters and

other crises for over 30 years; and

WHEREAS: During Preparedness Month, all Georgians are encouraged to adopt a proactive

mindset and take the necessary steps to prepare their families and communities to withstand and recover from unexpected events. We cannot always know when the next crisis will occur, but we can know that we will be prepared by committing ourselves to

a culture of resilience; now

THEREFORE: I, BRIAN P. KEMP, Governor of the State of Georgia, do hereby proclaim October

2021 as GEORGIA PREPAREDNESS MONTH in Georgia.
