WHEREAS:

The public and many medical professionals are unaware of heterotaxy

syndrome. Families struggle to educate medical teams and are often the only

common thread between medical specialties; and

WHEREAS:

Morality is high, but due to the lack of tracking and research, the exact numbers

are unclear; and

WHEREAS:

Funding for research into the causes of heterotaxy syndrome, as well as holistic

treatment, are low; and

WHEREAS:

Heterotaxy Syndrome Awareness Day provides an opportunity for families whose lives have been affected by the condition to celebrate life and remember loved ones lost, honor dedicated health professionals, and to meet others and

know they are not alone; now

I, BRIAN P. KEMP, Governor of the State of Georgia, do hereby proclaim
