year, and Georgia residents own 5.07 million individual life insurance policies,

with coverage averaging \$135,000 per policyholder; and

WHEREAS: Life insurance companies are a significant employer and investor in the Georgia

economy, with 434 life insurers licensed to do business in Georgia; and

WHEREAS: During Life Insurance Awareness Month, Georgians should become more

aware of their life insurance needs and the resources available to them from

professionals; now

THEREFORE: I, BRIAN P. KEMP, Governor of the State of Georgia, do hereby proclaim

September 2021 as LIFE INSURANCE AWARENESS MONTH in Georgia.
