catastrophic events, working in dangerous conditions often far from their

families to make the scene safe for other public safety heroes; and

WHEREAS: Linemen work with thousands of volts of electricity high atop power lines 24

hours a day, 365 days a year, putting their lives on the line with little recognition

from the community regarding the danger of their work; and

WHEREAS: On this day, we recognize linemen, the electric utility profession, and the many

contributions of these brave men and women who work tirelessly, through even the harshest weather conditions, to provide dependable electricity to Georgians

in every community; and

WHEREAS: Georgia linemen – part of a long-standing personal, family, and professional

tradition - are devoted to service and deserve our appreciation on this day and

throughout the year; now

THEREFORE: I, BRIAN P. KEMP, Governor of the State of Georgia, do hereby proclaim

April 13, 2021, as LINEMEN APPRECIATION DAY in Georgia.
